Judge Buller appointed Chief Commissioner

The Provincial Court of British Columbia is both honoured and proud that Judge Marion Buller has been called on to be the Chief Commissioner to lead the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls. Judge Buller is a long standing member of the Provincial Court who was appointed a judge in 1994. She has demonstrated her leadership skills in a number of areas including her key role in the establishment of and sitting in our First Nations Courts. Her extensive experience, knowledge, and perspective will assist the inquiry to fulfill its mandate and carry out the important work set out in the terms of reference for the Commission.

Judge Buller has now fully retired from the bench in order to lead the Commission. Her last sitting day was August 31, 2016.
