



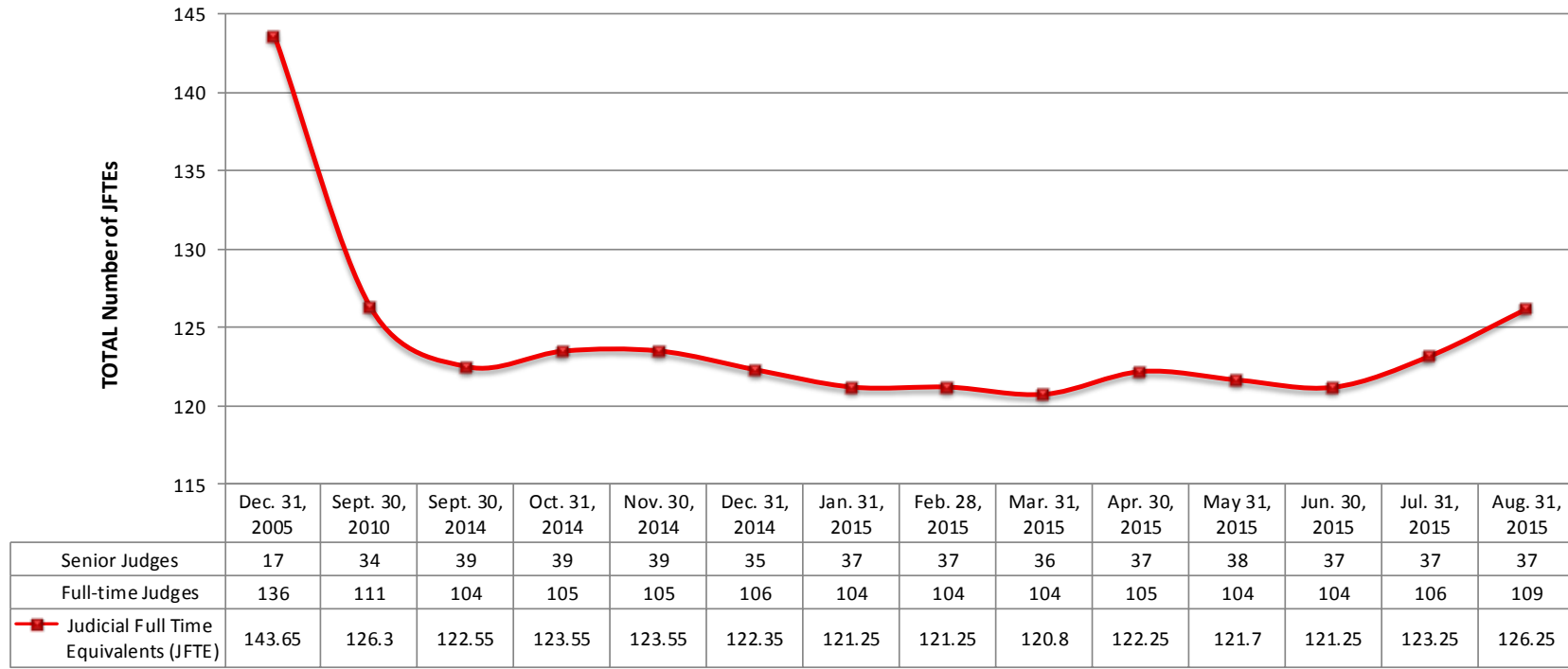

## Provincial Court of British Columbia Total Judge Complement and Judicial Full Time Equivalent (JFTE)



The red line in the table above shows judicial complement over time. The first value is the December 2005 value used as a baseline in the original Justice Delayed Report; the second value is the complement as at the date of the report (September 30, 2010). The rest of the values are as at the end of each month over the past year. These values are displayed as FTEs and include part time judges.

<sup>i</sup> The complement number shown here reflects the JFTE as of the first day of the next month. The election of a judge to senior status on the first day of a month is recorded as of the last day of the previous month.

<sup>ii</sup> JFTE = Judicial Full Time Equivalent positions. This includes all full time judge positions (1 JFTE) + all senior judge positions (0.45 JFTE) province wide. This total does not include the equivalent of 4.85 FTEs currently on full or partial Long Term Disability as of August 31, 2015.
